

Hypothermia can occur within an hour. A timely response can rescue lives!

GOOD PRACTICE

- Have an emergency plan ready and discuss this, so everyone knows what to in case of a POB (Person Overboard) situation.
- ∨ Practicing a dry-run of a POB situation.
- V Have emergency contact information at hand at all times.
- Know how to recognize hypothermia and how to act. (Also see SF 24-89 hypothermia)



BAD PRACTICE

- X Thinking it will not happen to you or one of your crew.
- X Not preparing yourself for a POB-situation.
- X Dismantling rescue equipment (because of maintenance/ operation) and not putting it back into operation.
- X Not (correctly) wearing a life-jacket.
- X No knowledge of how to act in case of hypothermia.
