SAFETY FLASH 24-98: Basic Agreements



Basic rules are essential for good and safe cooperation between two parties.

GOOD PRACTICE

- v Agree in advance which language will be spoken.
- v Ensure clear communication back and forth. If something is unclear or leaves room for assumptions, ask further.
- v Be aware of everyone's responsibilities.
- v Make agreements about the process and matters that are not on the checklists.
- v Wear the correct PPE and adhere to the rules.
- v Speak up if you have any doubts about safety.
- v Create a pleasant working atmosphere, ask about someone's day, have a cup of coffee together.
- v If you cannot resolve the issue together, contact the office/control room.



BAD PRACTICE

- x Make assumptions.
 Do not ASSUME: it makes an ASS out of U and ME
- x Begin your (work)day tired.
- x Not being open to help from the shore.
- x Not taking it seriously when someone addresses you.
